

Detailed Rules of Engagement: Believers in Solidarity

1. Anyone engaged in our silent protest must:
 - a. Agree to our rules.
 - b. Undergo training before the event (7:00 Monday the 16th, or for those who cannot make this time, a brief overview will be given at 5:00 on the 17th).
2. Please arrive at the agreed upon gathering point by 5:00 so that we can be on the street no later than 5:30.
3. Only authorized signs are permitted.
4. Clothing:
 - a. Wear comfortable shoes.
 - b. Do not bring a backpack to the event, leave it in your vehicle.
 - c. Try to dress business casual, neat. Avoid jeans if you can.
 - d. Do not bring anything that could be construed as a weapon, Swiss army knife, multi-tool, etc.
5. Alcohol: Zero tolerance for 24 hours before event.
6. We will pass out water, do not bring your own.
7. If you need any medication, inhaler etc.; don't forget.
8. Leave your emergency contact information at sign-up sheet:
9. DO NOT ENGAGE WITH PEOPLE ATTENDING THE EVENT. THIS IS A SILENT PROTEST.
10. Refer ALL press inquiries to authorized spokespersons (Bailey Bubach, Sarah Coen-Tuff).
11. ALWAYS listen to police and our authorized security team.
12. We will leave at promptly 6:35 p.m. We will not be there after the event.

Summary: This is not a discussion forum in which we are going to engage. We recognize their right to free speech. We recognize their right to hold their event. We recognize their right to rent the Empire. There is a high likelihood they will try to provoke you. Do not take the bait. Be your brother/sisters keepers, do not allow them to engage. Anyone, we mean anyone, who engages with attendees or non-members of our silent protest will be asked to leave.
