We ask that all participants refrain from engaging with event attendees and abide by the standards for the event that have been established in collaboration with the Grand Forks Police Department. **The speaker at this event is known for provoking his audience members to violence, so this request for silence and peace from demonstrators is of the utmost importance.* Anyone not abiding by the standards of the GFPD or our event coordinators will be removed from this event.
